Hippy Chic was sired by the 2008 G1 Maturity Classic winner Paddy's Flame who was trained by legendary Gippsland trainer Peter Giles.

Garry Allen also trains Wot Price Flash's litter sister Tree Climber Liv who has also been a model of consistency with 1 win and 6 places from 9 starts.
