

The Warragul Greyhound Club is giving community groups and sporting clubs across Gippsland the chance to be part of the Gippsland Festival and the opportunity to win a share of the total prize pool of \$11,000 in cash prizes.

How it works

- Community groups will be allocated a greyhound in the heats of the Warragul Cup on Friday
 5 Jan 2024
- The Winner of each heat will progress to the Warragul Cup Final on Friday 12 Jan 2024
- On the final Friday 12 Jan 2024 -
 - The community group allocated the Warragul Cup first place greyhound will win \$5,000. The community group allocated the Warragul cup second place greyhound will win \$3,000. The community group allocated the Warragul cup third place greyhound will win \$2,000. The community group allocated the Warragul cup fourth greyhound will win \$1,000.
- Entry into the competition is free for all community and sporting groups.
- Each club that is in the cup final will be allocated 2 free tickets to attend the event. Additional tickets can be purchased at \$85.00 per person including 3 course meal, beer, wine, and soft drink.

Conditions of entry

- 1. The 2024 Warragul Cup community competition is open to all incorporated Victorian community groups and organisations.
- 2. Registration for the competition will open on 18 December 2023 and close on 4 January 2024
- 3. 56 community groups will be randomly selected from the eligible registrations to participate at the sole discretion of the Warragul Greyhound Club.
- 4. Successful clubs will be notified via email Monday 8 Jan 2024
- 5. Each community group will be randomly allocated their greyhound after the fields for the Warragul Cup are drawn.
- 6. The Warragul heats will be run on Friday 5 Jan 2024
- 7. The Warragul Cup will be run on Friday 12 Jan 2024
- 8. The competition prize pool is \$11,000.00, consisting of \$5,000 for first place, \$3,000 for second, \$2,000 for third and \$1,000 for fourth.
- 9. Each club that is in the cup final will be allocated 2 free tickets to attend the event. Additional tickets can be purchased at \$85.00 per person including 3 course meal, beer, wine and soft drink.
- 10. By registering for this competition, community groups allow the reasonable use of their groups name and associated images in the promotion of the competition.
